 - It must be received in the store before 10 pm or be post-office postmarked on or before **May 28**. We will not accept postage-due ballots.
- We cannot accept two ballots from one shareholder, although you may submit a subsequent ballot if you note on the envelope that it **supercedes** your previous ballot & date it. Community property shareholders can submit **one** ballot with an envelope signed by either (or both) — if each submit separate ballots, the shareholders must instruct us which to count, or **neither** will be.
